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Introduction

It was also good to catch up at the NHF Finance conference in March on the Castleton stand. We look forward to meeting more of our users in the forthcoming user sessions and scoping workshops this Spring.

This is our regular newsletter to keep you up to date with ongoing initiatives and inform / invite you to proposed new projects at HousingBrixx. We are also letting you know about the progress of in-flight projects and informing you of what to expect from the HousingBrixx team during our continuous plan to deliver more advanced, new and better products and customer services.

Projects

At Castleton, our philosophy regarding development of the HousingBrixx system is moving to an approach that is more proactive in consulting the user base and partners with respect to enhancements and desired functionality. This will bring a more structured approach to our investment in the development of the system. A number of projects are already well on the way and there will be further opportunities for you to get involved, as explained below.

Later in this newsletter, there is an overview roadmap for the HousingBrixx system which will summarise the projects in this section and where they fall in our development plans. At the moment, this is still high level because we have not completed all the detailed scoping sessions (and therefore don't know the exact content & the time required) but we feel that it's important for you to know what will be forthcoming and roughly when to expect it.

Dashboard



This is another ongoing project to deliver a new dashboard to the solution. As a new product it is described in more detail in the products section of this newsletter and also has its own forum page [here](#) where you can contribute.



Housekeeping

The object set in HousingBrixx has grown over many years and is now very large. We are working on a couple of initiatives to rationalise the content whilst retaining a degree of the required, older functionality. We understand that a lot of our customers still use the old functionality and, for example, have their loan covenants frozen on UK GAAP for a number of years so we are not about to remove this functionality. However, we need to start to remove some of the ancient parts that should no longer be used.

The main mechanism to initiate this is to help users to identify which objects have been superseded and by what. This will be done using a series of switchable warnings that help and encourage users to move away from unsupported objects and migrate plans onto later objects that are being updated and improved all the time.

This housekeeping project also includes an overhaul of the 'Favourites' objects and their Help Texts to make sure that everything is fully up to date. As always, your input is gratefully received and you can get involved via [this sub-forum](#).

Following feedback from the user groups we are running a working group and scoping session on all things intercompany on 26th April in Sutton Coldfield. General enhancement requests

In the last newsletter we included some information about moving to an automated, web-based ticketing system for support purposes. For other internal Castleton reasons we are delaying this slightly while the back-office systems are improved to enable a wider function including:

- Handling of support requests
- A knowledge base for customer reference
- Web-based interface to view and update ticket status
- Reporting of Castleton's performance on support queries
- Handing of product features and enhancement requests

Whilst we are undertaking these back-office changes we do not want to delay the mechanism by which you can inform us of your enhancements and suggestions. Therefore, we are going to move this function to the forum where you currently download the



solution. There is a specific [features section](#) where we invite you to post enhancement and feature requests. If you agree or disagree with any of the proposals then please express your opinions – we will use this information to promote items up or down the development list, according to their popularity.

Training

We have set open training dates for the coming quarter and you can download the list of these [here](#). In response to your feedback, we are now going to run extra courses in the more central location of Sutton Coldfield. Open training courses will carry on in Henley, and we'll continue to deliver selected courses at your offices, on request. If you have any other preferred locations for public training courses then let us know and if we have enough interest we will run them.

We have changed the names of the, slightly misleading, "Foundation" and "Advanced" courses to "Day 1" and "Day 2", in response to your queries. The old naming convention suggested that users could see their way around a HousingBrixx model by attending only the first course. However, the content of the courses is very different and the second day is no more difficult than the first – it just deals with different topics. Both days are required for users to be able to build and flex a HousingBrixx model and hopefully the new naming convention will help to explain this.

HousingBrixx communications & IT

Hosting

As per our last newsletter, you are telling us that a centrally-hosted version of HousingBrixx would be really useful. We have fifteen customers who are now interested in trialling this service so we have linked up with [Castleton Managed Services](#) to provide HousingBrixx in the cloud.



This multi-tenanted, hosted version of the HousingBrixx system, which will alleviate customer IT issues and expand our range of services, is currently in testing with some of the largest and most complex HousingBrixx models and in the coming months we will be releasing this for general testing to the fifteen organisations.

All updates will be taken care of by us, automatically on release and you will be able to open your plans in a chosen version of the system (current version and previous version, for example). You simply log in; choose your version; open your plan and work as normal. The system is available 24/7 from any location with an internet connection. Plans are backed up automatically and disaster recovery systems are in place as standard.

Products and roadmaps

HousingBrixx

Since our last newsletter we have released a maintenance update in March which addresses a few critical bugs and addresses some over-zealous warnings that were introduced in December. Full details of the build notes and the install file can be downloaded from our [forum download area](#).

Our next release of the HousingBrixx solution will deliver the FFR 2018 & SHR returns and work is progressing well. This build addresses very few issues and focusses almost exclusively on the regulatory returns. It includes a new validation report for the FFR so that users will be able to check for hard & soft errors before exporting the plan to the FFR. We hope that this will save a lot of time in completing the return. Assuming that there are no last-minute surprises from the HCA or SHR then we are on track to deliver this towards the end of April.

After that we aim to release quarterly and, we anticipate releasing updates according to the following approximate timescales. We will provide more accurate roadmaps once we have scoped and completed technical specifications for all the projects. The definition of a "quarter" in the roadmap below is the financial quarter where the year starts April 1st 2018.

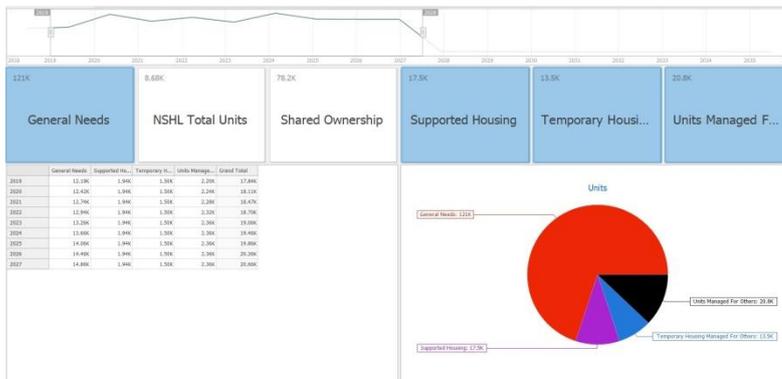

This is an intended roadmap at the point of publishing and timings are likely to change once we have completed scoping and technical documentation.

Graphing & Dashboards

On 8th March we held the preliminary meeting of the Dashboard Working Group at our head offices in Sutton Coldfield. Thanks to those who braved the weather and gave up their time in exchange for lunch, we were able to establish the first pass of requirements for the new HousingBrixx dashboard.



Phase 1 of this project will deliver a dashboard of standard VfM metrics and is due for delivery in the autumn.

There will be further meetings and workshops so if you are interested in joining this initiative then

Phase 2 of the project will deliver multiple scenarios in the dashboards. Phase 3 will be a fully-interactive dashboard that allows the user to change values of key inputs in the dashboard itself. Those inputs will be pushed back through the HousingBrixx model, the outputs captured and used to update the dashboard, without the requirement to run the HousingBrixx plan.

Importer

On 27th February we held a scoping session for the HousingBrixx Importer. In summary, the general consensus is that this is a really useful product that saves users many days of time but that it also needs to be:

- kept up to date with the latest changes to the HousingBrixx development objects
- de-restricted with respect to the 100 lines
- extended to allow the import of other external information
- productised and supported via the help desk and accompanying documentation
- licensed and with a proper installer
- developed in partnership with SDS and M3 so that the outputs from PamWin & Proval are compatible with the import formats of the HousingBrixx Importer

The first step in this project has been to update the Importer with respect to the first point above and to publish a [video on the forum](#) explaining current functionality. Users are now invited to comment on the functionality described in the video and make suggestions on the [forum](#) for future enhancements. Please let us have your comments by the middle of April so that we can draw up technical specifications while your Year End work is underway.

Pamwin & SDS have been included on this project and are happy to be involved and work in partnership with us on this.

We are now updating the installer for the Importer and then it will be made available for download once we have completing testing.
